

RISK DISCLOSURE

The board of directors ("**Board**") of African Dawn Capital Limited and its subsidiary companies ("**Afdawn Group**") acknowledges that it is accountable for Afdawn Group's process of risk management and systems of internal control. Each of Afdawn Group's operating subsidiaries similarly has its own board of directors responsible for the risk management and systems of internal control of such company and its business.

The following risk management measures have been implemented as a minimum at Afdawn Group and its investees:

- Detailed risk assessments, containing the identified risk(s) together with control(s) implemented to mitigate such risk(s) to the extent possible; and
- The internal audit tasks remain with the Afdawn Group audit and risk committee ("**Audit and Risk Committee**") for the time being until the internal audit department assumes responsibility for all internal audit matters.

The Board, on recommendation from the Audit and Risk Committee, concluded that the systems and processes of internal control and the risk management at Afdawn Group were effective for the financial year ended 29 February 2024. The Board was satisfied that there were no material breakdowns in controls at Afdawn Group during the past financial year.
